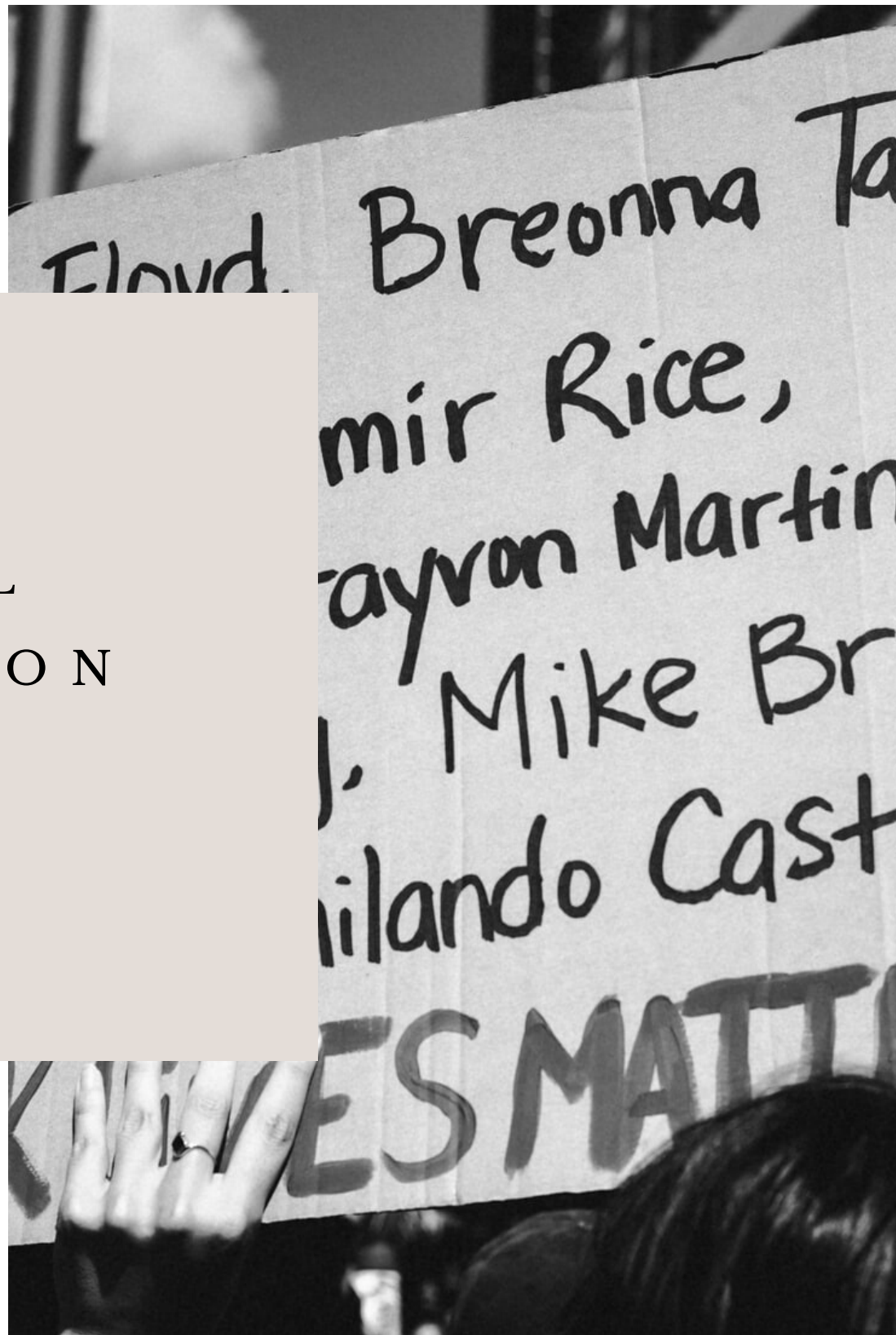

3. When you see injustice happening what do you tend to do? Speak up or stay silent? Why?



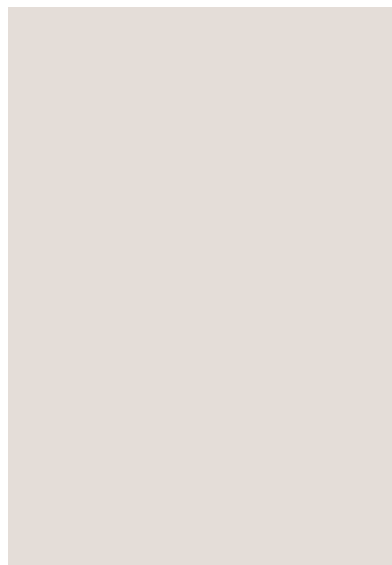
